- 10. Inspection procedure and fining for noncompliance.

## SUMMARY:

- 2. Removal of split rail fence at club house and Hickory at the Park entrance
- 3. Get bids on fixing low voltage lighting at the clubhouse
- 4. Put pump on a timer. Dwight will get pond's treatment status report
- 5. Dwight Dwornik reported it would cost approximately \$10800.00 for signs to be made. Suggest we get volunteers to do the background fencing and installation to save money. Dwight will do pricing of fencing from Home Depot
- 6. Inspection procedure, fining processes will be revised and finalized as follows:
  - 1. Assessments Late Fees. Raise from a one -time \$50 to \$75
  - 2. Accounting Fees Change from the staggering process to \$30 per month until Assessment is paid
  - 3. Violation Fines \$50 per month until violation is corrected

Will need to notify ARMS and members as well as place on website. Target Implemetnation September 1, 2023

Will include verbiage "nonpayment of assessments and fines can result in a lien being placed on your home" to all notices and invoices.
